DO BALLANTINE'S CONTAIN RECOGNISED ALLERGENS? (SEE NOTE 1)

No. We can confirm that our current product range do not contain allergens.

Although alcohol is made using cereals, gluten protein does not pass distillation and cannot be found in the finished product.

We would always advise that individuals check with their physician / doctor that it is safe for them to consume alcoholic beverages as in some cases, alcohol may increase sensitivity to allergens.

WHAT IS THE SHELF LIFE OF BALLANTINE'S DRINKS?

We would like to confirm there is **no shelf life** required for our current product range.

Distilled Spirits are shelf stable at ambient temperatures.

However we do recommend that all our products are stored in a cool (10-25°C), well ventilated environment of medium humidity which is free from odours, as this will maintain them in optimum condition.

NOTE 1

Under EU regulations if products contain any of the recognized 14 allergens they must be reported on product labelling.

The list of allergens are: Cereals containing gluten, Crustaceans, Eggs, Fish, Peanuts, Soybeans, Milk (including lactose), Nuts, Celery , Mustard, Sesame, Sulphur dioxide/ sulphites, Lupin, Molluscs.
